
Throughout ICAO Annex 9 where the term "Contracting States" is used it refers to Bhutan unless reference is made to "another Contracting States".

With Bhutan, in this context, are meant the basic Authorities in Bhutan, which have jurisdiction over the subjects in question, such as aviation, customs, security, immigration, police etc.

Each Authority decides to what extent the recommendations contained in ICAO Annex 9 will be applied.

Note: The following paragraphs refer to the obligations of aircraft operators and pilots-in-command: 3.33, 3.43, 3.45, 5.9, 5.10, 5.11, 6.30.1, 6.35.2, 7.2, 7.4 and 8.16.
