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Preamble

The Performance Agreement is entered into between the Secretary and Director General.

The objectives of this Performance Agreement are:

- To establish clarity and consensus about annual priorities for the consistent with the o11th Five Year Plan of the Ministry, and Government's other priorities;
- b) To provide an objective and fair basis for evaluating the overall performance of the at the end of the financial year
